SCAM ALERT

Every day, community members are at risk of being the target of a scam.

Here are some tips to keep yourself safe.

- Be aware that scammers will pretend to be from a familiar organization (they have technology to change the phone number shown on your phone to match a trusted organization).
- Scammers often contact you about a fake prize you've "won" or a problem with an account you hold. (NEVER give out private information to any caller).
- They will often tell you that you need to act immediately and pay in a specific way. They may threaten to arrest you, take your license away or cancel any services you may have.

Don't give your personal or financial information in response to a request that you didn't expect. Honest organizations won't call, email, or text to ask for your personal information. If you get an email or text message from a company you do business with and you think it's real, it's still best not to click on any links. Instead, contact them using a website you know is trustworthy or look up their phone number. Don't call a number they gave you or the number from your caller ID.

Resist the pressure to act immediately. Honest businesses will give you time to make a decision. Anyone who pressures you to pay or give them your personal information is a scammer.
