## Getting to Know Your Money

It's important to know what your money looks like and how much it is worth!

## How much is your money worth?

A Penny is worth One Cent (100 Pennies= \$1 Dollar Bill)  
A Nickel is worth Five Cents (20 Nickels= \$1 Dollar Bill)  
A Dime is worth Ten Cents (10 Dimes= \$1 Dollar Bill)  
A Quarter is worth Twenty Five Cents (4 Quarters= \$1 Dollar Bill)



## Rice Krispie Snowmen

We are seeing a lot of snowmen popping up this wintry season. Here's a yummy treat to enjoy as you come in out of the cold.

- Powdered Sugar
- Black Frosting
- Orange Candies
- Red Thin Rope Licorice
- Rice Krispie Treats
- Circle Cookie Cutters
- Fudge Stripe Cookies
- Mini Peanut Butter Cups



Make your Rice Krispie Treats as directed on the box. Once cooled, use different sized cookie cutters to make small, medium, and large circles. Dip and roll each treat in powdered sugar. Stack treats on top of each other. Large treat on the bottom, then medium, and small. Use black frosting to make the eyes, mouth, and buttons. Add an orange candy for a nose. (Good N Plenty work good). Add a scarf of licorice around the neck. To top off your snowman, put a fudge stripe cookie upside down with a peanut butter cup on top! Yummy!
